Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 395.

This bill would authorize the governing body of a municipal corporation to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the municipal corporation property tax imposed on rental dwellings of owners who provide reduced rent for elderly or disabled renters.

House Bill 898, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 395.

Senate Bill No. 395

AN ACT concerning

Municipal Corporation Property Tax Credit – Reduced Rent for Elderly or Disabled Renters

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of a ~~county or~~ municipal corporation to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the ~~county or~~ municipal corporation property tax imposed on rental dwellings of owners who provide reduced rent for elderly or ~~disable~~ disabled renters; and generally relating to authorization for a local property tax credit for rental dwellings of owners who provide reduced rent for elderly or disabled renters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
