AN ACT concerning

Dentists - Continuing Education

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Dental Examiners, after consulting with certain persons, to establish to adopt regulations establishing continuing education requirements for licensed dentists; requiring licensed dentists to submit satisfactory evidence of compliance with certain continuing education requirements when renewing their license to practice dentistry; specifying that the Board may not require compliance with certain regulations until after a certain date; authorizing the Board to credit towards satisfaction of certain continuing education requirements certain courses completed within a certain time period; and generally relating to continuing education requirements for dentists.
