- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "GRANT" MEANS THE HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE INCENTIVE GRANT FOR ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS OFFERING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS LEADING TO LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION IN HEALTH OCCUPATIONS DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY.
- (3) "ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION" MEANS AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION THAT:
- (I) IS APPROVED TO OPERATE BY THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION; AND
- (II) PRODUCES GRADUATES ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE APPROPRIATE NATIONAL EXAMINATION FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION IN THE RELEVANT HEALTH OCCUPATION DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY.
 - (4) "HEALTH OCCUPATION" MEANS A:
 - (I) PHYSICAL THERAPIST;
 - (II) OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST;
 - (III) RADIOGRAPHER;
 - (IV) RESPIRATORY THERAPIST;
 - (V) LABORATORY TECHNICIAN; OR
 - (VI) MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIST.; OR
 - (VII) PHARMACIST.
- (B) (1) THERE IS A HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM FOR ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS.
- (2) THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADMINISTER THE GRANT PROGRAM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- (3) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT PROGRAM.
- (C) AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION IS QUALIFIED TO RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE INSTITUTION:
