

Senate Bill No. 420

AN ACT concerning

Family Law – Child Care Administration Advisory Council

FOR the purpose of establishing a Child Care Administration Advisory Council in the Department of Human Resources; specifying the membership, appointment, term, and duties of the Council; requiring the Council to advise and counsel the Child Care Administration of the Department, review certain issues and regulations, and identify certain child care issues; providing for members to serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses; defining ~~a certain term~~ certain terms; and generally relating to the Child Care Administration Advisory Council.

Section 5-590 through 5-593 to be under the new part “Part IX. Child Care Administration Advisory Council”

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
