- (A) (1) THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF AT LEAST 20 21 MEMBERS, BUT NO MORE THAN 25 MEMBERS.
- (2) IN APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE COUNCIL, THE SECRETARY SHALL, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, APPOINT MEMBERS REPRESENTING GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE JURISDICTIONS ACROSS THE STATE.

(B) THE MEMBERS SHALL INCLUDE:

- (1) 1 MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (2) 1 MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;
- (3) 1 REPRESENTATIVE EACH FROM THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS OR STATE AGENCIES APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVISE OF THE SECRETARY:
- (I) THE CATHOLIC ARCHDIOCESE OF BALTIMORE OR WASHINGTON, D.C.;
 - (II) THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS;
 - (III) AN ASSOCIATION OF CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS:
 - (IV) AN ASSOCIATION OF MONTESSORI SCHOOLS;
- (V) THE ASSOCIATION FOR INDEPENDENT MARYLAND SCHOOLS:
- (VI) THE BOARD OF JEWISH EDUCATION OF BALTIMORE OR WASHINGTON;
 - (VII) THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT;
- (VIII) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE:
- (IX) THE CHILD CARE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES;
- (X) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES;
 - (XI) THE HEAD START PROGRAM;
- (XII)—THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION FOR THE EDUCATION OF YOUNG CHILDREN:
 - (XIII) THE MARYLAND CHILD CARE ASSOCIATION;
 - (XIV) THE MARYLAND FAMILY DAY CARE ASSOCIATION:
