SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

16-101.

- (f) (1) "Practice podiatry" means to diagnose or surgically, medically, or mechanically treat any ailment of the human foot AND ANKLE AND THEIR RELATED GOVERNING STRUCTURES THE ANATOMICAL STRUCTURES THAT ATTACH TO THE FOOT.
 - (2) "Practice podiatry" does not include:
 - (i) [Arthrodesis of two or more tarsal bones;
 - (ii) Complete tarsal osteotomy; or
 - (iii)] Administration of an anesthetic, other than a local anesthetic;
- (II) OPEN OR CLOSED REDUCTION OF ANKLE FRACTURES WITH MANIPULATION;
 - (III) REPAIR OF ACUTE ACHILLES' TENDON RUPTURE;
 - (IV) ANKLE ARTHRODESES; OR
 - (V) REPAIR OF CHRONIC LATERAL ANKLE INSTABILITY.

16-103.

(A) IN ADDITION TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A LICENSED PODIATRIST MAY PERFORM SURGICAL PROCEDURES ON THE ANKLE ONLY IF THE LICENSED PODIATRIST HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A PROGRAM ACCEPTABLE TO THE HOSPITAL CONSIDERING THE PODIATRIST'S APPLICATION FOR PRIVILEGES TO PERFORM SURGICAL PROCEDURES ON THE ANKLE.
