

(3) THE ASSOCIATION OR REPRESENTATION OF PERSONS IN NEGOTIATING, SETTING, MAINTAINING, OR CHANGING TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT; OR

(4) ANY OTHER CONTROVERSY ARISING OUT OF THE RESPECTIVE INTERESTS OF EMPLOYEE OR EMPLOYER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 74(3).

In item (3) of this subsection, the word "setting" is substituted for the former word "fixing", for clarity and to conform to terminology used in other revised articles of the Code.

Also in item (3) of this subsection, the former reference to "seeking to arrange" conditions of employment is deleted as included in the word "negotiating".

The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes that, although the word "terms" is deleted as included in the word "conditions" in other parts of this article, the reference to "terms or conditions" of employment is retained in item (3) of this section and throughout this subtitle, since "terms and conditions of employment" is a longstanding term of art in this area of the law.

(D) PERSON PARTICIPATING OR INTERESTED IN A LABOR DISPUTE.

"PERSON PARTICIPATING OR INTERESTED IN A LABOR DISPUTE" MEANS A PERSON AGAINST WHOM RELIEF IS SOUGHT IF THE PERSON:

(1) IS ENGAGED IN THE INDUSTRY, CRAFT, TRADE, OR OCCUPATION IN WHICH THE DISPUTE OCCURS; OR

(2) IS AN AGENT, MEMBER, OR OFFICER OF AN ASSOCIATION OF EMPLOYEES OR EMPLOYERS ENGAGED IN THE INDUSTRY, CRAFT, TRADE, OR OCCUPATION IN WHICH THE DISPUTE OCCURS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 74(2).

The former reference to an "association" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "person".
