- (II) OPERATE AN ASIAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE SUCCESSFULLY; OR
- (III) PROMOTE THE ESTABLISHMENT AND SUCCESSFUL OPERATION OF ASIAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES: AND
- (6) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF LAW AND THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS:
- (I) PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND MANAGERIAL ASSISTANCE TO ASIAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES:
- (II) PROVIDE THE MANAGERIAL AND ORGANIZATIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR PRIVATE ENTITIES AND UNITS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT TO PLAN AND CARRY OUT JOINT UNDERTAKINGS THAT RELATE TO ASIAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES: AND
- (III) PAY, WHOLLY OR PARTLY, THE COSTS OF A PILOT OR DEMONSTRATION PROJECT THAT IS INTENDED TO OVERCOME THE SPECIAL PROBLEMS OF ASIAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES.

ON OR BEFORE THE 15TH DAY OF EACH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE DIRECTOR SHALL SEND AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE OFFICE OF ASIAN AFFAIRS:

- (1) TO THE GOVERNOR; AND
- (2) SUBJECT TO § 2 1312 OF THIS ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
  - (a) "Asian-Pacific American" means an individual with national origins from:
    - (1) the following Asian countries:
      - (i) Burma;
      - (ii) Thailand;
      - (iii) Malaysia;
      - (iv) Indonesia;
      - (v) Singapore;
      - (vi) Brunei;
      - (vii) Japan;
      - (viii) China;
      - (ix) Taiwan;
      - (x) Laos;
