(3) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES, OR A DESIGNEE OF THE SECRETARY WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH ISSUES;

(4) 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM;

(5) 1 MEMBER FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RESPONSIBLE FOR HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMS OR SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMS;

(6) 1 MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(7) 1 MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND NOMINATED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(8) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON ADOLESCENT PREGNANCY;

(9) 3 MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE MEDICAL PROFESSIONS CONCERNED WITH MATERNAL AND INFANT HEALTH, OBSTETRICS, PEDIATRICS, OR MIDWIFERY;

(10) 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING HOSPITALS WITH AN OBSTETRICAL DEPARTMENT;

(11) 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS;

(12) 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS;

(13) 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING ORGANIZATIONS THAT ADVOCATE FOR MATERNAL AND INFANT HEALTH;

(14) 1 FACULTY MEMBER FROM A MARYLAND MEDICAL SCHOOL RESPONSIBLE FOR A RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM IN OBSTETRICS OR FAMILY PRACTICE;

(15) 1 MEMBER WITH EXPERTISE IN MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH RESEARCH; AND

(16) 3 MEMBERS FROM THE PUBLIC.

(B) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE COMMISSION IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:

(1) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND
