- (1) 3 YEARS; AND
- (2) STAGGERED.

~~(C)~~ (D) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A)(9) THROUGH (16) SHALL CONTINUE TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

~~(D)~~ (E) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A)(9) THROUGH (16) OF THIS SECTION AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SHALL SERVE FOR THE REST OF THE TERM OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.
