This bill would increase the number of resident circuit court judges in Washington County from 3 to 4, in Montgomery County from 14 to 15, and in Prince George's County from 18 to 19.

House Bill 895, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 691.
