(4) TOTAL NUMBER OF WOMEN COVERED, BY AGE CATEGORIES;

(5) TOTAL NUMBER OF SCREENING MAMMOGRAMS PER YEAR BY AGE CATEGORIES;

(6) TOTAL AMOUNT PAID FOR SCREENING MAMMOGRAMS;

(7) TOTAL AMOUNT PAID FOR THE TREATMENT OF BREAST CANCER, BY STAGE OF THE DISEASE AND AGE CATEGORIES, AND

(8) PREMIUM COSTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to contracts and policies issued, delivered, or renewed on or after July 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 767.

This bill would establish a Community Supported Living Arrangements Services Program in the Developmental Disabilities Administration to provide services to individuals with developmental disabilities.

House Bill 1009, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 24, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 767.
