(A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE LICENSING OF PERSONS WHO PROVIDE COMMUNITY SUPPORTED LIVING ARRANGEMENTS SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS THAT INCLUDE STANDARDS FOR:

(1) LICENSING PROVIDERS THAT INCLUDE:
