Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 814.

This bill would authorize county boards of education to lease school property for the construction or operation of group day care centers.

House Bill 1188, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 9, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 814.

Senate Bill No. 814

AN ACT concerning

Education - Public Schools - Day Care Programs

FOR the purpose of authorizing county boards of education to lease certain school property for the construction or operation of group day care centers under certain circumstances; making technical corrections; providing that a certain lease entered into before a certain date by a county board of education is deemed authorized under the provisions of this Act; generally relating to the use of certain school property by group day care centers; and making this Act an emergency measure.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
