

(3) Include an asking price at which the owner is willing to sell an easement;
and

(4) Include a complete description of the subject land.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 2-508(b) and 2-510(b) of the Agriculture Article, the Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation may elect, for fiscal years 1992 and 1993 only, to have one offer cycle.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 61.

This bill would authorize an exemption from municipal corporation property taxation for real property owned by persons who under certain conditions agree to maintain a minimum percentage of residential units as housing for low to moderate income households.

Senate Bill 244, which was passed by the General Assembly and was signed by me on April 30, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 61.

Municipal Corporations – Property Tax Relief – Low to Moderate Income Housing

FOR the purpose of authorizing an exemption from municipal corporation property taxation for certain real property owned by certain persons who under certain conditions agree to maintain a portion of the real property certain specified minimum percentage of residential units as housing for low to moderate income
