

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the former qualifying words "duly authorized" are deleted as unnecessary, since the word "agent" means a person who is duly authorized to act for another.

In subsection (c) of this section, the former minimum penalty is deleted, to conform to the statement of legislative policy in Art. 27, § 643 of the Code, which sets forth the general rule that, notwithstanding a statutory minimum penalty, a court may impose a lesser penalty of the same character. The District Court has exclusive original jurisdiction over criminal offenses for which the penalty is less than \$2,500. In 1972, the power conferred under Art. 27, § 643 was extended to the District Court, with respect to crimes that existed at that time, including former Art. 27, § 552, which was enacted by Ch. 340, Acts of 1941.

In subsection (d) of this section, the former words "association" and "corporation" are deleted as unnecessary in light of the word "organization".

Also in subsection (d) of this section, the word "private", which formerly modified the word "property", is deleted to conform to subsection (b) of this section. Former Art. 27, § 552 used the words "private property" and "property" interchangeably.

4-403. STRIKEBREAKERS.

(A) RECRUITMENT RESTRICTED.

A PERSON WHO IS NOT DIRECTLY INTERESTED IN A STRIKE MAY NOT PROVIDE, OBTAIN, RECRUIT, OR REFER, FOR EMPLOYMENT IN PLACE OF A STRIKER, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CUSTOMARILY AND REPEATEDLY OFFERS TO BE EMPLOYED IN PLACE OF STRIKERS.

(B) EMPLOYMENT AS STRIKEBREAKER RESTRICTED.

AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CUSTOMARILY AND REPEATEDLY OFFERS TO BE EMPLOYED IN PLACE OF STRIKERS MAY NOT TAKE OR OFFER TO TAKE THE POSITION OF A STRIKER.

(C) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR BOTH.

In subsections (a) and (c) of this section, the former enumerations "partnership, agency, firm, or corporation, or officer or agent thereof" and "partnership, agency, firm or corporation" are deleted as unnecessary in light
