

Square Hospital Center has until June 1, 1993, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 612.

Senate Bill 715, which was passed by the General Assembly and was signed by me on April 30, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 612.
