In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 642.

This bill would authorize the public school employer in Garrett County to negotiate a service or representation fee with employee organizations.

Senate Bill 421, which was passed by the General Assembly and was signed by me on May 14, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 642.

House Bill No. 642

AN ACT concerning

Education – Garrett County – Negotiation of Representation Fee

FOR the purpose of authorizing the public school employer in Garrett County to negotiate a service or representation fee with certain employee organizations, to be paid by certain employees; exempting certain employees from a service or representation fee; and providing for the effective date of this Act.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Education

Section 6-407

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1989 Replacement Volume and 1990 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

6-407.

(a) An employee organization designated as an exclusive representative shall be the negotiating agent of all public school employees in the unit in the county.
