SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

5-1201.

- (i) ["School"] "PRIVATE SCHOOL" means a [public or] privately operated elementary, secondary, postsecondary, or noncollegiate institution, with facilities in use on or before April 1, 1987, which is:
 - (1) Located within the airport noise zone; and
 - (2) Certified or accredited by the State Board of Education.
- (J) "PUBLIC SCHOOL" MEANS AN ELEMENTARY, SECONDARY, POSTSECONDARY, OR NONCOLLEGIATE INSTITUTION OPERATED BY A PUBLIC ENTITY WITH FACILITIES IN USE ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 1987, WHICH IS:
 - (1) LOCATED WITHIN THE AIRPORT NOISE ZONE; AND
- (2) CERTIFIED OR ACCREDITED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PUBLIC SCHOOL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR EXISTING PUBLIC SCHOOLS THAT OCCUPY REAL PROPERTY IN THOSE COMMUNITIES AND NEIGHBORHOODS IDENTIFIED
