SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

5-1201.

(i) ~~{“School”}~~ ~~“PRIVATE SCHOOL”~~ means a {public or} privately operated elementary, secondary, postsecondary, or noncollegiate institution, with facilities in use on or before April 1, 1987, which is:

- (1) Located within the airport noise zone; and
- (2) Certified or accredited by the State Board of Education.

~~(j) “PUBLIC SCHOOL” MEANS AN ELEMENTARY, SECONDARY, POSTSECONDARY, OR NONCOLLEGIATE INSTITUTION OPERATED BY A PUBLIC ENTITY WITH FACILITIES IN USE ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 1987, WHICH IS:~~

- ~~(1) LOCATED WITHIN THE AIRPORT NOISE ZONE; AND~~
- ~~(2) CERTIFIED OR ACCREDITED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.~~

~~(2) Submit to the 1988 Session of the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, a report on the results of the program, including a study of the feasibility of making noise attenuating improvements to PUBLIC AND PRIVATE schools; and~~
