

(II) A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.

(2) "EMPLOYER" INCLUDES:

(I) A PERSON WHO OPERATES OR OWNS A TAXICAB BUSINESS IN BALTIMORE CITY AND LEASES OR RENTS A TAXICAB TO A LICENSED TAXICAB DRIVER, TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC;

(II) A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN A BUSINESS THAT DIRECTLY EMPLOYS INDIVIDUALS TO PROVIDE PART-TIME OR TEMPORARY HELP TO ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR PERSON; AND

(III) A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR PERSON WHO CONTRACTS DIRECTLY WITH ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN A BUSINESS THAT DIRECTLY EMPLOYS INDIVIDUALS TO PROVIDE PART-TIME OR TEMPORARY HELP TO ANOTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR PERSON.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 89, § 29(b).

In the introductory language of paragraph (1) of this subsection, the referenced exception is added to reflect that, in Subtitle 4 of this title, "employer" is defined to exclude certain farmers.

In paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection, the phrase "in that business" is added to conform to subsection (c)(1) of this section.

Also in paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection, the former reference to "wages, salaries, or on commission" is deleted as unnecessary in light of subsection (c) of this section.

As to the addition of the references to "governmental unit" in paragraph (2)(ii) and (iii) of this subsection, see the revisor's note to subsection (c) of this section.

(E) OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARD.

"OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARD" MEANS A REGULATION THAT REQUIRES:

(1) A CONDITION THAT IS REASONABLY APPROPRIATE OR NECESSARY TO MAKE EMPLOYMENT AND PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT SAFE AND HEALTHFUL; OR
