

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the sales and use tax on the retail sale or use of cigarettes shall be computed without deductions.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for Fiscal Year 1992 only and from only those additional sales and use tax revenues resulting from this Act that are credited to the State General Fund for Fiscal Year 1992, and from no other funds, and subject to the provisions of law relating to budgetary procedure to the extent applicable, the amount specified below, or as much thereof as required to accomplish the designated purpose, is hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed from as much of those additional revenues as are received by the State:

For Fiscal Year 1992 only, the following amount to be used only to provide funds for the operation of the Lida Lee Tall Learning Resources Center and any of these funds remaining at the close of the fiscal year shall revert to the General Fund:

General Fund Appropriation\$500,000.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(1) There shall be a Task Force to study alternative mechanisms and funding sources to provide a permanent structure for the financial support of the Lida Lee Tall Learning Resources Center.

(2) The Task Force shall consist of: the State Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's designee; 1 member appointed by the Governor; 3 parents of students attending the institution, selected by the Board of Trustees; the Presidents, or their designees, of the Lida Lee Tall Learning Resources Center, of Towson State University, and of Morgan State University; the Mayor of Baltimore City or the Mayor's designee; the County Executive of Baltimore County, or the County Executive's designee; 1 representative selected by the Baltimore County Board of Education; 1 representative selected by the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore City; 2 members of the Senate of Maryland, selected by the President of the Senate; and 2 members of the House of Delegates, selected by the Speaker of the House.

(3) The Task Force shall receive such staff, administrative, and other support services as may be provided by the State Department of Education.

(4) The Task Force shall submit a final report containing its recommendations for a permanent system of financial support for the Lida Lee Tall Learning Resources Center to the Governor, the President of the Senate of Maryland, and the Speaker of the House of Delegates no later than December 15, 1991.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(1) There shall be a Task Force to develop a plan for the dissemination, by September 1, 1992, of information, curricula, and other programs consistent with the mission of the Lida Lee Tall Learning Resources Center to the public schools of the State.
