SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

To qualify for a license, an applicant shall:

- (1) COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF §§ 10-701, 10-702, 10-703, 10-704, 10-706, 10-707, 10-708, AND 10-709 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- [(1)] (2) (I) Have a certificate of accreditation from the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals for the private inpatient facility to be operated; or
- [(2)] (II) Meet the requirements that the Secretary adopts under this subtitle.

- (b) (1) To resolve expeditiously a complaint that alleges the existence of any nonlife-threatening deficiency, the Department shall refer the complaint directly to the hospital.
- (2) If appropriate, issues relating to the practice of medicine or the licensure or conduct of a health professional shall be referred to the hospital and may be referred to the appropriate licensure board for resolution.
- (3) If the Department determines that the hospital has not satisfactorily addressed the referred complaint or where the complaint alleges the existence of a life threatening deficiency, the Department shall conduct an independent investigation.
