

(x) (1) Unless an election is made under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a member of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in Worcester County is not a covered employee.

(2) The Board of County Commissioners for Worcester County may provide by resolution for the members of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in the county to be covered employees while on duty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1991.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1197.

This bill would permit a judge of the Baltimore City Orphans' Court, who is an attorney, to take actions on behalf of the court.

Senate Bill 750, which was passed by the General Assembly and was signed by me on April 9, 1991, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1197.
