CHARTER AMENDMENT NO. 90-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW CARROLLTON, MARYLAND, TO AMEND SECTION 20 OF THE CITY CHARTER SO AS TO REDUCE FROM FIFTEEN PER CENTUM (15%) TO EIGHT PER CENTUM (8%) THE PER CENTUM OF QUALIFIED VOTERS REQUIRED TO INITIATE A PROPOSED ORDINANCE OR A RESOLUTION, OTHER THAN A RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION BY A PETITION PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS.

CHARTER AMENDMENT NO. 90-03

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND (SECTION 9 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, EVERSTINE'S 1963 EDITION, AS AMENDED) AMENDING SUBSECTION (a), ENTITLED "TAX RATE," OR SECTION 12 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS," TO MODIFY A MAXIMUM TAX RATE NOT TO EXCEED THE RATE OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) ASSESSED VALUATION OF TAXABLE PROPERTY OR FRANCHISE WITHIN SAID CITY.

CHARTER AMENDMENT NO. 90-04

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND (SECTION 9 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, EVERSTINE'S 1963 EDITION, AS AMENDED) AMENDING SUBSECTION b. (2) OF SECTION 3 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "ELECTED OFFICIALS: VACANCIES," TO MODIFY THE PROCEDURE FOR VACANCIES IN THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, AND TO REQUIRE A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN SIXTY DAYS OF SAID VACANCY.
