

MUNICIPAL CHARTERS

RESOLUTION to authorize and empower the Commissioners of the Town of Sharptown, Maryland, to make expenditures for supplies, materials, equipment, construction of public improvements, or contractual services involving less than \$5,000 by written contract without advertisement for sealed bids.

[Section SHC 4-22 of the Charter of the Town of Sharptown, Wicomico County, as found in the compilation of Municipal Charters of Maryland (1990 Replacement Edition), repealed and reenacted, with amendments.

Effective Date September 25, 1990]

RESOLUTION to establish qualifications of voters by requiring a person to be a citizen of the United States at least 18 years of age who has resided in the State of Maryland and the Town of Sharptown, for 30 days next preceding any Town election and is registered to vote in the State of Maryland.
