

KENT COUNTY

Section 5-31 of Article II, of Chapter 5, Code of Public Local Laws of Kent County (1984 Edition, being Article 15 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland) title "Kent County" sub-title "Health and Safety", making littering unlawful on private lands of another or public lands and providing a rebuttable presumption that any article so found bearing a person's name and/or address shall be presumed to be the property of such person and that such person placed or caused to be placed such article where found and changing the penalty for violation of Article II to a "municipal infraction".

Passed July 3, 1990.

Emergency Bill No. 6-90

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Section 5-109 of Article XI, Chapter 5, Code of Public Local Laws of Kent County, (being Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Kent County" sub-title "Health and Safety", correcting BOCA reference errors and providing that in addition to the enclosures required for swimming pools, a natural barrier, pool cover or other protective devices approved by the County Commissioners shall be acceptable enclosures.

Passed September 4, 1990.

Emergency Bill No. 7-90

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact Section 5-59(A), Article V, Chapter 5 of the Public Local Laws of Kent County, Maryland, entitled, "Additional Fee for 911 Emergency Telephone Systems", to provide for an increase in the current "911" fee by twenty (20) cents per month, to be applied to all current telephone bills for switched local exchange access in Kent County.

Passed October 2, 1990.

Bill No. 8-90

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Section 1.2, Article I of Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Kent County, (1989 Edition being Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Kent County" sub-title "County Commissioners", to increase the salary of the County Commissioners of Kent County, and reimburse the Commissioners for expenses.

Effective Date November 16, 1990.
