AN ACT concerning

Title 27 "Records Management"

FOR the purpose of repealing the section that deals with the purpose of title 27; for repealing and amending sections that contain definitions by deleting the definition of nonrecord, that deal with the powers and duties of the records management officer, the disposal of records, and certificate of disposal of records.
