AN ACT concerning

**Title 28 "Recreation and Parks"**

FOR the purpose of repealing sections dealing with the use of firearms on Lake Roland ~~and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Mayor and City Council~~; repealing and reenacting sections dealing with the composition of the Board of Recreation and Parks, the powers of the Board, the annual report, authority of the director and penalties.

**Bill No. 3-90**

AN ACT concerning

**Title 30 "Roads, Bridges, Sidewalks & Storm Water Drainage"**

FOR the purpose of repealing sections dealing with the liability of the county, serving of notices, bond for the roads engineer, responsibilities of the roads engineer, procedure for opening of alleys, tax levy for sidewalks, costs of removal of snow and ice, authority to establish freeways, method and procedure of acquiring property for freeways and regulation of use and access; repealing and reenacting sections describing the rights and powers of the county over roads, the requirement of contractor's bonds, dealing with franchises, powers of the roads engineer, endorsement of bills and claims, approval of general plan for streets and highways, declaration of a road as highway, procedure for improving public roads, for opening and closing roads, leasehold ownership, procedure for requiring abutting owners to construct and repair roads and curbs, removal of snow, authority to designate freeways, access to freeways, right of ingress and egress, application for repairs of alleys, and with the depositing of certain materials in the street.
