

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE :

Throughout this subtitle, references to "regulation[s]" are substituted for the former references to "rule[s], regulation[s and] standard[s]", while the defined term "occupational safety and health standard" is substituted for the former references to "standard" when it appeared alone. In the revision of Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article, the then Commission to Revise the Annotated Code decided to distinguish, to the extent possible, between regulations of executive units and rules of judicial or legislative units and to establish consistency in the use of these words. Thus, in each article revised since 1984, the word "regulation" has been substituted for the word "rule" or the word "rule" has been deleted where "regulation" also appeared.

Also throughout this subtitle, the former references to "modifications, amendments or revocations thereof" are deleted as unnecessary since a regulation is amended or revoked through the adoption of a later regulation. See the definition of "regulation" in SG § 10-101(e).

SUBTITLE 4. ACCESS TO INFORMATION ABOUT HAZARDOUS AND TOXIC
SUBSTANCES.

5-401. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
INDICATED.

(B) EMPLOYEE.

(1) "EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN EMPLOYEE (AS DEFINED IN § 5-101 OF THIS TITLE) OR FORMER EMPLOYEE WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL MAY BE EXPOSED UNDER NORMAL OPERATING CONDITIONS OR FORESEEABLE EMERGENCIES.

(2) "EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES:

(I) A LINE SUPERVISOR;

(II) A MAINTENANCE WORKER;

(III) A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER OF A VOLUNTEER
FIRE, AMBULANCE, OR RESCUE COMPANY;

(IV) OPERATING PERSONNEL; AND

(V) A PRODUCTION WORKER.
