HOWARD COUNTY

Resolution No. 1

RESOLUTION proposing to amend Section 705 "Appeals" of Article VII "Merit System" of the Howard County Charter to provide that aggrieved applicants and employees may appeal certain matters to the Personnel Board; to provide that aggrieved applicants and employees may appeal other matters to the appointing authority or the Personnel Officer; to permit the Personnel Board, under certain conditions, to hear appeals from decisions of the appointing authority or the Personnel Officer; to require that decisions of the Personnel Board shall be consistent with provisions of the Charter and Howard County law; and to clarify language regarding employee appeals; and submitting this amendment to the voters of Howard County for their acceptance or rejection in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.
