Resolution No. 2

RESOLUTION proposing to amend Section 202 "The County Council" of Article II "The Legislative Branch" and Section 302 "The County Executive" of Article III "The Executive Branch" of the Howard County Charter to make certain language concurrent with that of Section 5(AA) of Article 25A of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and submitting this amendment to the voters of Howard County for their acceptance or rejection in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.

Approved by voters at General Election November 6, 1990.

Resolution No. 16

RESOLUTION proposing to amend Section 901 "Conflict of Interest" of Article IX "General Provisions" of the Howard County Charter to authorize the County Council to delegate to the Howard County Ethics Commission the power to authorize a County employee or official to own certain stocks or to have certain business connections when it is determined that such ownership or connection does not violate the public interest; to require that any act delegating this power shall provide procedures, including a public hearing, and establish criteria for making such determinations; and submitting this amendment to the voters of Howard County for their acceptance or rejection in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.

Approved by voters at General Election November 6, 1990.

Resolution No. 33

RESOLUTION proposing (1) to amend Section 616 "Borrowing limitations" of Article VI "Budgetary and Fiscal Procedures" of the Howard County Charter in order to clarify that all bonds and other evidences of indebtedness shall be sold at public sale, subject to the limitation that bonds or other evidences of indebtedness may be sold by private (negotiated) sale if the Council determines that either (a) a public sale is not practical or (b) significant benefits to the County are achievable only by private (negotiated) sale; and (2) to amend Section 618 "Contents of bond issue authorization ordinances" of Article VI of the Howard County Charter in order to provide that bond issue authorization ordinances shall recite either the procedure for the public sale of the proposed issue or the findings and determinations required for a private (negotiated) sale of the proposed issue; and submitting this amendment to the voters of Howard County for their acceptance or rejection in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.

Approved by voters at General Election November 6, 1990.
