COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

Bill No. 40

AN ACT amending various sections of Title 1 "Personnel Administration" to provide an annual salary adjustment for County employees and to 'arify the working hours of certain employees.

Effective Date July 1, 1990.

Bill No. 51

AN ACT adding new subtitle 10 "Howard County Housing Commission - Articles of Organization" to Title 13 "Housing, Urban Renewal and Economic Development" of the Howard County Code to establish articles of organization for the Howard County Housing Commission; make certain declarations and findings; define certain terms; provide for the number, appointment and terms of the Commissioners; specify the powers and duties of the Commission; designate a custodian of records; require the Commission to make certain reports and adopt certain procedures; authorize the County Executive to waive certain advertising and bidding requirements relating to the sale of certain real property to the Commission; require Commissioners to file statements of financial interests; specify the terms of the initial Commissioners; make this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relate to the Howard County Housing Commission; to amend Section 22.205 "Financial Disclosure" of the Howard County Code to add the Housing Commission to the list of boards and commissions whose members are subject to the disclosure provisions of the Howard County Public Ethics law; and to amend Section 23.102 "Cooperation with other governmental agencies" of the Howard County Code to add the Housing Commission to the list of agencies with which the County may cooperate and enter into agreements to provide comprehensive risk management.

Bill No. 55

AN ACT amending the Growth Management Act of 1989 to modify the definition "builder/developer" and to clarify the process to reflect these modified definitions and declaring this to be an emergency measure if approved by an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the members of the County Council.

Effective Date July 6, 1990.
