5-404. WAIVER OF A RIGHT.

(A) PROHIBITED ACT.

AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT ASK OR REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE TO WAIVE ANY RIGHT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR 29 C.F.R. 1910.1200.

(B) WAIVER VOID.

A WAIVER OF A RIGHT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR 29 C.F.R. 1910.1200 IS VOID.

5-405. CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A CONSUMER PRODUCT OR FOODSTUFF THAT IS:

(1) PACKAGED FOR DISTRIBUTION TO AND INTENDED FOR USE BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC; AND

(2) HANDLED UNOPENED OR STORED UNOPENED IN A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT, INCLUDING ITS STOREROOM OR WAREHOUSE.

(B) DUTY OF EMPLOYER.

(1) TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF 29 C.F.R. 1910.1200(E)(1)(I) FOR A LIST OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS, EACH EMPLOYER SHALL COMPILE AND MAINTAIN A CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST FOR EACH HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL THAT IS FORMULATED, HANDLED, MANUFACTURED, PACKAGED, PROCESSED, REACTED, REPACKAGED, STORED, OR TRANSFERRED IN THE WORKPLACE OF THE EMPLOYER.
