COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

- (13) Revise rules against County employees and officials misusing the prestige of their office, exercising improper influence, or interfering with the freedom of any person to engage in political activities;
 - (14) Clarify rules regarding ex parte communications;
- (15) Revise and establish rules governing the solicitation and acceptance of gifts by County employees and officials;
- (16) Revise and establish requirements for financial disclosure by County employees and officials;
- (17) Revise and establish rules on lobbying and the disclosure of lobbying activities;
- (18) Clarify the enforcement powers of the Ethics Commission, County Attorney, and the Courts;
 - (19) Clarify certain record keeping requirements;
- (20) Clarify the authority of the Merit System Protection Board and the Ethics Commission to act on complaints filed by employees concerning improper actions in County government;
- (21) Revise and clarify the statement of findings, legislative intent, and rules of statutory construction;
 - (22) Revise the rules regarding conflicts of laws; and
 - (23) Generally revise and clarify the Montgomery County Public Ethics Law.
