Chapter 24

Laws of Montgomery County, 1990

AN ACT to:

(1) prohibit the issuance of a building permit for [[certain residential buildings, including single-family homes and]] certain group residences[[,]] after certain dates unless the plans include the installation of a fire sprinkler system;

(2) require builders of certain dwelling units to offer to install a fire sprinkler system before a contract for construction or sale is signed;

[[(2)]] (4) require the installation of fire sprinkler systems in certain model single-family homes after a certain date;

[[(3)]] (4) repeal obsolete language; and

[[(3)]] (5) generally amend the building code provisions requiring fire sprinkler systems in residential buildings.
