AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

[[(1) extend the period of time during which work must be commenced before a permit becomes invalid for building permits applied for after a certain date;]]

[[(2)] (1) extend the period of time [[for the start of footings and the second inspection for construction of certain buildings]] before a building permit becomes invalid [[for building permits applied for after a certain date]];

[[(3)] (2) alter requirements for the extension of a valid building permit and specify a certain fee for an extension; and

[[(4)] (3) generally alter the law related to the validity of building permits.
