- (7) provide for transfers of a franchise;
- (8) establish a Cable Communications Advisory Committee;
- (9) provide for administration and enforcement of this Act;
- (10) provide for revocation or termination of a franchise;
- (11) specify minimum requirements for a community access organization; and
- (12) generally revise County law regulating a cable communications franchise.
