A BILL TO CORRECT BILL 322 OF 1987, TO BRING THE COUNTY TRANSFER TAX ORDINANCE INTO LINE WITH THE STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION

WHEREAS, THE MARYLAND STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION, AUTHORIZING TALBOT COUNTY TO ADOPT COUNTY TRANSFER TAXES IN CHAPTER 672 OF THE ACTS OF THE ASSEMBLY OF 1987, STATES, INTER ALIA, THAT "THE TAX AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING THAT CONVEYS TITLE OR INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY BY OR TO THE FOLLOWING OR ANY UNIT OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE UNITED STATES;
2. THE STATE; OR
3. ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.", AND

WHEREAS, THE PRESENCE OF THE WORD "TO" IN LINE NINE (9) OF SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 1, OF TALBOT COUNTY BILL 322 GIVES RISE TO CONFUSION OR IS IN CONFLICT WITH THE STATED INTENT OF THE STATE ENABLING ACT, AND

WHEREAS, IT WAS THE INTENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO EXEMPT FROM THE COUNTY TRANSFER TAX CONVEYANCES TO CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS, BUT SAME WAS NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION, NOW THEREFORE,
