7-203. MISCELLANEOUS POWERS AND DUTIES.

(A) POWERS.

IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSIONER:

- (1) MAY ACCEPT FROM ANY SOURCE A GRANT TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE; AND
- (2) TO ADMINISTER OR ENFORCE THIS TITLE, MAY CERTIFY TO OFFICIAL ACTS.
 - (B) DUTY.

IN ADDITION TO ANY DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL KEEP A CENTRAL PUBLIC REGISTRY OF ALL LICENSED FARM LABOR CONTRACTORS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the fourth sentence of former Art. 100, § 80B(e) and, as it related to keeping a list of licensees, the second sentence of § 80D(a) and, as it related to certifying to official acts, § 80E(d)(3).

The introductory phrases of subsections (a) and (b) of this section, "[i]n addition to any [powers and duties] set forth elsewhere", are added to clarify that the enumerated powers and duties are not exhaustive.

In subsection (a)(1) of this section, the former power to accept grants "from the federal government" is deleted in light of § 2–105(b)(3) of this article, which requires the Commissioner to "accept each grant that Congress appropriates for a matter within the jurisdiction of the Division".

Also in subsection (a)(1) of this section, the former phrase "of money" is deleted as implicit in the word "grant".

In subsection (b) of this section, the defined term "licensed farm labor contracto[r]" is substituted for the former reference to "persons issued a certificate of registration", since the intent of the General Assembly seemed to be to require a list of individuals currently authorized to perform farm labor contracting services.
