## SUBTITLE 3. LICENSING.

## 7-301. LICENSE REQUIRED.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE COMMISSIONER BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY PERFORM A FARM LABOR CONTRACTING SERVICE IN THE STATE FOR CONSIDERATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 80B(a)(1).

The words "perform a farm labor contracting service ... for consideration" are substituted for the former words "act as a farm labor contractor", for clarity. See the General Revisor's Note to this title.

## 7-302. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL:

- (1) SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSIONER:
- (I) AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER PROVIDES; AND
- (II) 2 RECENT, PASSPORT SIZED, COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE APPLICANT: AND
  - (2) PAY TO THE COMMISSIONER AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$25.
  - (B) CONTENTS OF APPLICATION FORM.

THE APPLICATION SHALL STATE:

- (1) THE PERMANENT PLACE OF RESIDENCE OF THE APPLICANT;
- (2) EACH ADDRESS WHERE THE APPLICANT EXPECTS TO RESIDE WHILE IN THE STATE;
- (3) EACH FARM LABOR CONTRACTING SERVICE THAT THE APPLICANT WILL PERFORM FOR CONSIDERATION;
