The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that former Art. 100, \$80B(c)(2) — now subsection (d) of this section — referred to an agricultural operation having "custody" of a migrant agricultural worker. Although the term "custody" is retained in the revision, the Committee questions whether this is an appropriate use of the term.

7-303. INVESTIGATION.

ON RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INVESTIGATE, AS APPROPRIATE, TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE APPLICANT IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the reference, in former Art. 100, § 80B(b), to an "appropriate investigation".

The reference to a determination "whether the applicant is entitled to be licensed" is added to state expressly the purpose of the investigation.

7-304. ISSUANCE AND CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

(A) ISSUANCE.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) CONTENTS.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ATTACH TO EACH LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE LICENSEE.
