- (2) SENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE PERSON.
 - (D) REQUEST FOR HEARING.
- (1) WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER SERVICE OF AN ORDER UNDER THIS SECTION, THE PERSON MAY SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSIONER A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR A HEARING.
- (2) UNLESS A PERSON REQUESTS A HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE ORDER IS FINAL.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (c), and (d) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 80E(e).

Subsection (b) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 80E(c). Although former § 80E(c) was placed immediately after the provisions on disciplinary proceedings against a licensee, former § 80E(c) is revised in this section also, in light of the broad reference to "proceedings before the Commissioner under [former §§ 80A through 80F]".

In subsection (d)(2) of this section, the phrase "in accordance with paragraph (1) of this subsection" is added to clarify that not only must a request be made but it must be timely and in writing.

7-312. SECURITY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER MAY REQUIRE A FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR TO POST A SURETY BOND OR OTHER SECURITY IF THE COMMISSIONER:

- (1) FINDS THAT THE FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR HAS VIOLATED A PROVISION OF THIS TITLE OR ANY ORDER THAT THE COMMISSIONER PASSES OR REGULATION THAT THE COMMISSIONER ADOPTS; OR
- (2) RECEIVES A CERTIFIED RECORD OF THE FINDING OF A UNIT OF ANOTHER STATE OR THE UNITED STATES THAT THE FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR HAS VIOLATED ANY LAW THAT RELATES TO:
 - (I) REGISTRATION AS A FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR; OR
