

vehicle is insured. This revision also is supported by TR § 17-104(b), which requires the "owner" of a motor vehicle registered in the State to maintain security for the vehicle during the registration period. Unless the Motor Vehicle Administration accepts another form of security, under TR § 17-103(a), security is a "vehicle liability insurance policy written by an insurer authorized to write these policies in this State".

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the more precise references to "bodily" injury and "damage to" property are substituted for the former reference to "injury to persons or property" in light of TR § 17-103(b).

Also in subsection (c)(1) of this section, the word "and" is substituted for the former word "or" since the intent of the General Assembly seemed to be to require coverage against liability for both "bodily injury" and "damage to property".

In subsection (c)(2) of this section, the former word "regulation" is deleted in light of the broad reference to "law".

SUBTITLE 5. PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES.

7-501. PERFORMING FARM LABOR CONTRACTING SERVICE WITHOUT LICENSE.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT PERFORM A FARM LABOR CONTRACTING SERVICE IN THE STATE FOR CONSIDERATION UNLESS LICENSED BY THE COMMISSIONER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is standard language added to state a fundamental prohibition implicit throughout the provisions of former Art. 100, §§ 80A through 80F that related to performing farm labor contracting services. This addition is supported by former Art. 100, §§ 80B(a)(1) and 80E(e), which, respectively, required a person to be licensed before performing a farm labor contracting service for consideration and authorized the Commissioner to order a person who is not licensed to cease from performing a farm labor contracting service for consideration. See §§ 7-301 and 7-311 of this title, respectively.
