a farm labor contractor who is not licensed. It did not seem to be the intent of the General Assembly to allow a person to use a farm labor contractor to transport or provide housing for a migrant agricultural worker unless the person confirms that the farm labor contractor has a license.

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the phrase "after a person makes a request ..." is added to clarify the day from which the 5-day period is measured.

In subsection (b)(3) of this section, the reference to the "term" of a license is substituted for the former phrase "during the year that the certificate is in effect", since the term may be less than 1 year, § 7-306 of this title, and a license may not be in effect for the full term, § 7-308 of this title.

In subsection (c) of this section, the former prohibition against engaging a farm labor contractor "once that person ... has ... received actual notice" is deleted as misleading in light of subsection (a) of this section.

The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that, subsection (b)(3) of this section does not state a specific time limit during which the Commissioner must give notice of a change in the status of a license.

As to the substitution of the references to a "license" for the former references to a "certificate" of registration, see the General Revisor's Note to this title.
