7-506. CIVIL PENALTIES.

(A) IMPOSITION.

SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS IN THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER MAY ASSESS A CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY OR REPEATEDLY VIOLATES:

- (1) ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE;
- (2) ANY ORDER PASSED UNDER THIS TITLE; OR
- (3) ANY REGULATION ADOPTED TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE.
- (B) AMOUNT.

A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$5,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

- (C) CONSIDERATIONS.
- (1) BEFORE THE COMMISSIONER ASSESSES A CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST AN AGRICULTURAL OPERATION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CONSIDER THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE PENALTY IN RELATION TO:
 - (I) THE SIZE OF THE BUSINESS;
- (II) ANY GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH \S 7–503 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
 - (III) THE HISTORY OF PREVIOUS VIOLATIONS.
- (2) BEFORE THE COMMISSIONER ASSESSES A CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST A FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CONSIDER THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE PENALTY IN RELATION TO:
 - (I) THE SIZE OF THE BUSINESS;
 - (II) THE GRAVITY OF THE VIOLATION;
- (III) THE GOOD FAITH OF THE FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR;
- (IV) THE HISTORY OF PREVIOUS VIOLATIONS IN THIS STATE OR IN ANY OTHER STATE THAT RELATE TO LICENSING OR TO THE TREATMENT OF A MIGRANT AGRICULTURAL WORKER.
