

Also in the introductory language of subsection (a)(2)(iv) of this section, the former word "packaging" is deleted as included in the word "packing".

In subsection (a)(2)(iv)3 of this section, the word "and" is substituted for the former word "or", to clarify that "agricultural work" includes any of the employments listed in items (i) through (v) of subsection (a)(2).

In subsection (b) and the introductory language of subsection (c) of this section, the phrase "as defined in subsection (w) of this section", which formerly modified "agricultural labor", is deleted as unnecessary since the defined meaning is presumed to apply unless the context requires otherwise. Similarly, in the introductory language of subsection (d)(1) of this section, the phrase "as defined in paragraph (1) of this subsection", which formerly modified "employing unit", is deleted.

In the introductory language of subsection (c) of this section, the former phrase "after December 31, 1977" is deleted as obsolete.

In subsections (c)(1) and (e) of this section, the defined term "wages" is substituted for the former word "remuneration", to conform to terminology used throughout this title.

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the former reference to labor performed by an alien before July 1, 1988 is deleted as obsolete.

In subsection (d)(1)(i) of this section, the reference to the "Migrant and Seasonal Agricultural Worker Protection Act" is substituted for the former obsolete reference to the "Farm Labor Contractor Registration Act of 1963". The Farm Labor Contractor Registration Act of 1963 was repealed by Public Law 97-470, Title V, § 523 (1983). The provisions on registration of farm labor contractors are now included in the Migrant and Seasonal Agricultural Worker Protection Act.

In the introductory language of subsection (e) of this section, the defined term "wage" is substituted for the former word "remuneration", to conform to terminology used throughout this title.

The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that subsection (a)(2)(ii)1 of this section is limited to cases in which damage is caused by a hurricane, and that similar damage can result from other natural disasters. The Committee notes that the provision may be expanded to cover other natural disasters without raising a conformity issue.
