

In subsection (b)(3) of this section, the phrase "as amended", which formerly modified "Social Security Act", is deleted as unnecessary in light of Art. 1, § 21.

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the former phrase "in his name as treasurer of the said fund" is deleted as unnecessary in light of subsection (a) of this section.

Subsection (d)(3)(i) of this section is revised to "allow" use of the benefit account for payment of refunds in light of subsection (c)(3) of this section. As revised in subsection (d)(2), former § 10(c)(1) limited requisitions for the benefit account "solely" for payment of benefits and refunds, however the law did not require that refunds be paid "only" from the requisitioned money. Refunds could be paid out of the clearing account.

In subsection (d)(3)(ii), the former reference to "§ 903 of the Social Security Act" is deleted as unnecessary, since that provision is cited in § 8-405(d) of this subtitle. Items (i) through (iii) of subsection (d)(3) all are subject to § 8-405.

8-405. PROCEDURES FOR WITHDRAWALS FROM TRUST FUND ACCOUNT.

(A) BENEFITS AND REFUNDS.

(1) THE SECRETARY SHALL REQUISITION MONEY THAT IS CREDITED TO THE ACCOUNT OF THE STATE IN THE UNEMPLOYMENT TRUST FUND AS THE SECRETARY CONSIDERS NECESSARY FOR PAYMENT OF BENEFITS AND REFUNDS UNDER THIS TITLE FOR A REASONABLE PERIOD IN THE FUTURE.

(2) THE AMOUNT REQUISITIONED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE ACCOUNT.

(3) LAWS THAT REQUIRE AN APPROPRIATION OR OTHER FORMAL RELEASE OF MONEY IN THE CUSTODY OF STATE OFFICERS DO NOT APPLY WHEN MONEY THAT WAS REQUISITIONED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS USED TO PAY A BENEFIT OR REFUND FROM THE BENEFIT ACCOUNT OR A REFUND FROM THE CLEARING ACCOUNT.

(4) AFTER EXPIRATION OF THE PERIOD FOR WHICH A REQUISITION IS MADE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF MONEY REMAINS UNPAID OR UNCLAIMED IN THE BENEFIT ACCOUNT THE SECRETARY MAY:

(I) DEDUCT THE AMOUNT OF THE MONEY FROM ESTIMATES FOR A FUTURE REQUISITION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION; OR
