

In subsection (a)(4) of this section, the former word "sale" is deleted as included in the word "disposal".

Also in subsection (a)(4) of this section, the reference to "surplus" equipment or supplies is substituted for the former reference to equipment or supplies that "may no longer be necessary for the proper administration of this article", for brevity.

In subsection (a)(5)(i) of this section, the reference to the "General Assembly" is substituted for the former reference to the "State" for clarity, since only the General Assembly may "appropriate" money.

In subsection (a)(5)(ii) of this section, the former reference to the "United States" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to a "unit of the federal government", since any money received from the "United States" would be received through a unit of the federal government.

Also in subsection (a)(5)(ii) of this section, the former phrase "including the Social Security Board" is deleted as obsolete since the Social Security Board was abolished and its duties with respect to unemployment insurance were transferred to the Federal Security Administrator and then to the Secretary of Labor. See Part II of Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1939, § 4 of Reorganization Plan No. 2 of 1946, and § 1 of Reorganization Plan No. 2 of 1949 in the appendix to Title 5 of the U.S.C.A. In any event, the former phrase "including the Social Security Board" merely was illustrative of a unit of the federal government.

8-415. GENERAL OPERATION OF UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION FUND.

(A) ROLE OF STATE TREASURER.

THE STATE TREASURER IS CUSTODIAN OF THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION FUND.

(B) DEPOSITS AND DISBURSEMENTS.

(1) SUBJECT TO § 8-405(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE, MONEY SHALL BE DEPOSITED, ADMINISTERED, AND DISBURSED FROM THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS MONEY IS DEPOSITED AND DISBURSED FOR OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE STATE TREASURER.

(2) MONEY IN THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION FUND SHALL BE SECURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 6-209 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
