Also in the introductory language of subsection (a) of this section, the former language "any unencumbered balances in the Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund as of that date", is deleted as obsolete. Similarly, the phrase "after that date", which formerly modified "any moneys granted ... to this State pursuant to the provisions of the Wagner-Peyser Act", is deleted as obsolete.

8-419. ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY.

8-420. ADMINISTRATION.

(A) DUTY OF SECRETARY.

THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND.

- (B) SPECIAL FUND.
- (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL KEEP THE SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND AS A NONLAPSING FUND.
- (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, MONEY IN THE SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANY OTHER FUND.
  - REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language added to state expressly the duty of the Secretary to administer the Special Administrative Expense Fund.
